- Provide contact information of the institutional author of the tool or the distributor of the tool. Anyone interested in the tool will have to contact that author to receive the tool
- Provide a hyperlink to another internet location where the tool is hosted or stored
- Upload the tool itself with the institutional author's permission. This can be a PDF, a Word document, or audio

What is the Model Practice Program?

- Two Types of Practices: **Model** and **Promising**
- A **model practice** is an initiative, program, resource, or tool that demonstrates exemplary and replicable qualities in response to a local public health need. A model practice meets the following criteria: LHD role, collaboration, innovation responsiveness and evaluation (both process and outcome)
- A **promising practice** meets the following criteria: LHD role, collaboration, innovation, and responsiveness and some qualitative and quantitative evidence that the practice improves health outcomes. A promising practice exhibits the potential to become a model practice.
